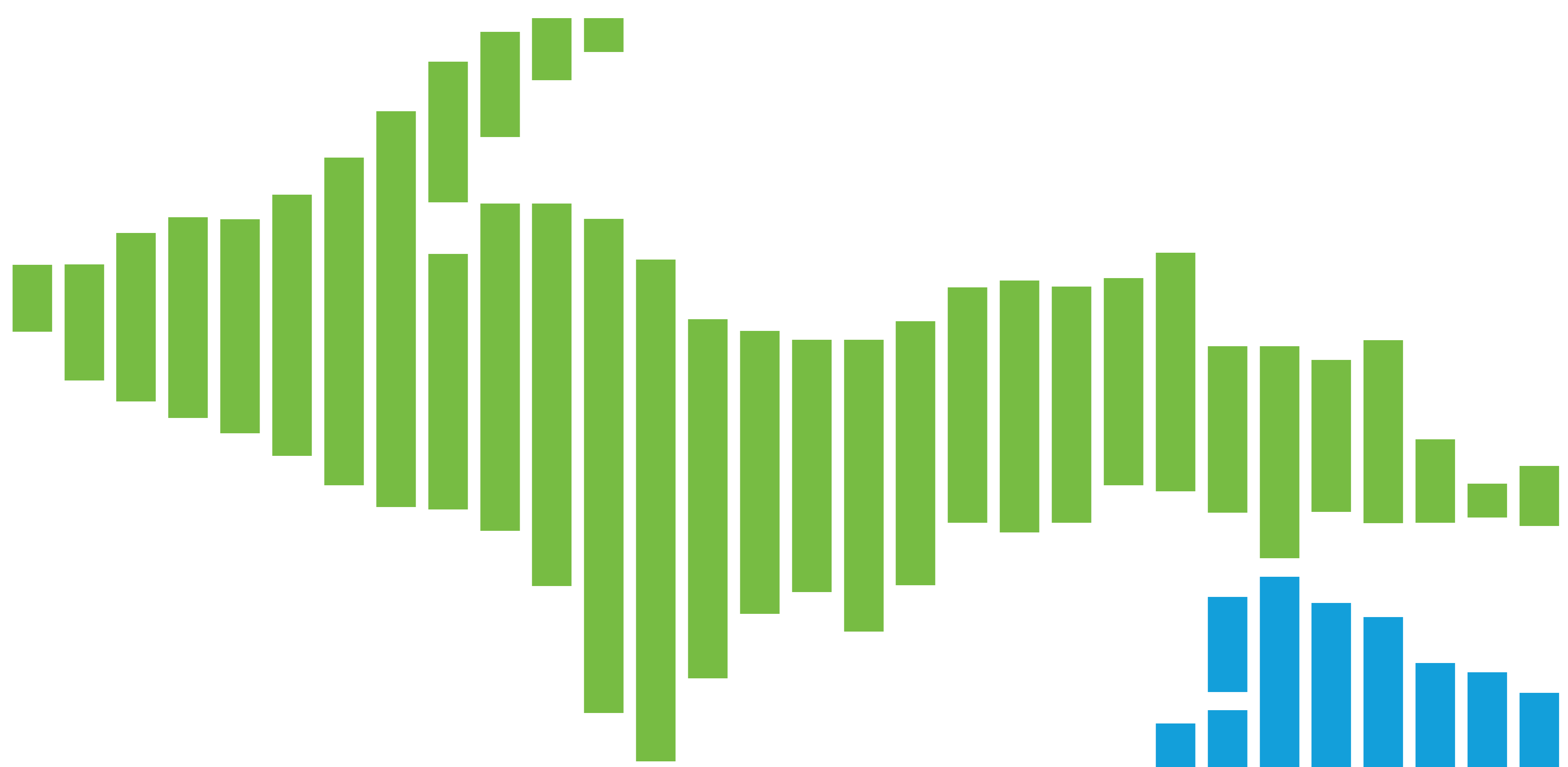
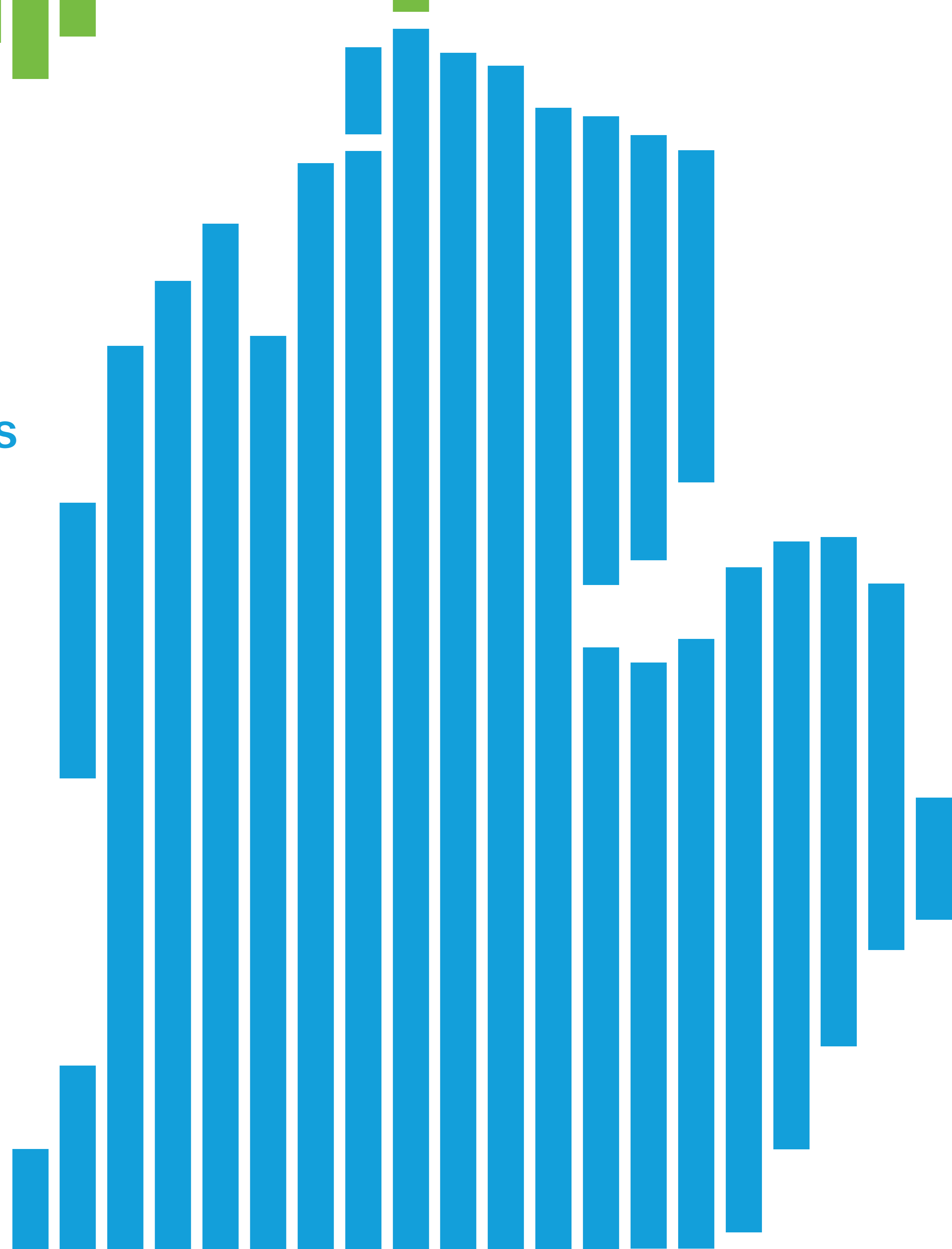


ECONOMIC IMPACT OF MICHIGAN'S MEDICAID EXPANSION

ECONOMIC IMPACT OF MICHIGAN'S MEDICAID EXPANSION



600,000

Michiganders have health insurance under the Healthy Michigan Plan, an expansion of Medicaid that makes it open to many more low-income adults.



\$413 MILLION

What the state's coffers will gain in the current fiscal year because of Medicaid expansion, even after paying 5% of the cost of care for HMP members. The projection includes both tax revenue on increased economic activity and avoided spending on other safety net programs.

2021

\$162 MILLION

What the state's coffers will gain from the Healthy Michigan Plan in 2021, when the state will have to cover 10% of total plan costs.
