# Michigan Poll on Healthy Aging

## Wave 3 Survey Data: Health and Household

**Topics:** health; disability; household; caregiving; social isolation and loneliness; volunteering

**Survey:** Michigan Poll on Healthy Aging Wave 3

**Fielded as part of:** National Poll on Healthy Aging (NPHA) Wave 16 Survey

**Survey period:** February 2025

**Survey mode:** Online or by telephone

**Sampled population:** Michigan adults age 50 and over

**Full sample:** 1353 Michigan adults age 50-95

**Margin of error:** +/- 4 percentage points for questions asked of Michigan adults age 50 and over; higher among subgroups

**Summary:** In February 2025, the [Michigan Poll on Healthy Aging](#) surveyed Michigan adults age 50 and over about **their health, household, experiences of disability, social isolation and loneliness, caregiving, and volunteering.**

This report presents results from poll data weighted to reflect the Michigan population. Most tables include comparisons by demographics and other characteristics. We show results by age, gender, race and ethnicity, household income, education, [region](#), urbancity, physical and mental health status, disability, chronic condition, and household composition (e.g., living alone). The tables also show how the responses of adults age 50 and older in Michigan compare to those in the rest of the United States. Each table includes weighted percentages and 95% confidence intervals (CI). Some results are omitted due to subgroup size of less than 50 people. The total number of respondents answering each question may vary as some respondents may not have answered every survey question.
